

**Notice of Public Hearing
for
Site Assignment Modification
Haverhill Board of Health**

Pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 111, Section 150A and 310 CMR 16.00, the Haverhill Board of Health will hold a public hearing on December 19, 2017 at 7:00 P.M. at City Hall, Room 301, 4 Summer Street, Haverhill, MA 01830, to consider the application for a modification to site assignment for an existing solid waste combustion facility located at 100 Recovery Way, Haverhill, MA 01835. The applicant is Covanta Haverhill, 100 Recovery Way, Haverhill, MA 01835. The proposed modification of the site assignment requests that the quantity of waste processed at the Facility, now an average of 1,650 tons per day, be increased by an amount equal to the tons of materials sent out for recycling, but not to exceed an average of 1,723 tons per day, on an annual basis. This will encourage the Facility to increase its recycling tonnage.

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection has issued a Report in which it determined that the proposed modification to the site assignment is suitable for the existing facility. Copies of the Department's Report on Suitability and the site suitability criteria (310 CMR 16.00) are available for copying and examination along with the application for site assignment at the offices of the Haverhill Board of Health and Inspection Services, City Hall, Room 210, 4 Summer Street, Haverhill, MA 01830 between the hours of 8 AM and 4 PM, Monday through Friday (phone 978-374-2338).
