ACCEPTABLE LIMITS AND AMOUNTS:

- 25 Gallons of liquid chemicals
- 25 Pounds of dry chemicals

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Pesticides, Polishes, Waxes, Wood Strippers, Wood Stains, Pool Chemicals, Photo Chemicals, Drain Cleaners, Brake Fluid, Muriatic Acid, Degreasers, Car Wax, Antifreeze, Old Gasoline, Creosote, Wood Preservative, Solvents, Sealants, Oil Paint, Ni-Cd Batteries, Fluorescent bulbs

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Latex Paint, Electronics, Asbestos, Motor Oil, Propane Tanks, Explosives, Radioactive Waste, Fire Extinguishers, Car Batteries, Smoke Detectors, Appliances, and Tires (see below).

The following items can be disposed of at the Recycling Center, 500 Primrose Street, 978-420-3817. For all payments, pay online and print receipt for onsite attendant at the Recycling Center front office. Checks will also be accepted onsite (no cash).

Motor Oil—On the last Saturday of each month from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. There is a five (5) gallon limit – no charge.

Appliances and Scrap Metal—Hot water heaters, dishwashers, Dryers, Washers, Stoves, Microwaves, Refrigerators, Freezers, and Air Conditioners on Wednesday and Saturdays 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. \$15.00 per appliance.

Tires—Can be disposed of on Wednesdays and Saturdays 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. Tires DO NOT have to be off the rims. A fee of \$ 5.00 for passenger and \$ 10.00 for Truck tires.

Propane Tanks—On Wednesdays and Saturdays from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. Cost is \$ 5.00 each.

Mercury Containing Products— On Wednesdays and Saturdays from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm – no charge
