Acceptable Limits and Amounts:

25 Gallons of liquid chemicals

25 Pounds of dry chemicals for safe collection and disposal

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Pesticides, Polishes, Waxes, Wood Strippers, Wood Stains, Pool Chemicals, Photo Chemicals, Drain Cleaners, Brake Fluid, Muriatic Acid, Degreasers, Car Wax, Antifreeze, Creosote, Solvents, Wood Preservatives, Sealants, Oil Paint, Batteries, Fluorescent bulbs.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Latex Paint – Once dry, it can be disposed in regular trash.

Motor Oil - Last Saturday of the month at DPW - 9:00a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Asbestos, Explosives, Radioactive Waste, Propane Tanks, Fire Extinguishers, Car Batteries, Smoke Detectors, Appliances, Tires.

Tires, propane tanks, appliances and scrap metal can be disposed of at the Recycling Center on 500 Primrose St. on Wednesdays and Saturdays - 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Tires DO NOT need to be off rims. Car Batteries can be disposed of at Haverhill Salvage, 81 Hale Street.
