### **Pollworkers must be Massachusetts Registered Voters – preference given to Haverhill Residents.**

Pollworkers are required to attend a training for which they are paid as long as they work the election day.

Election day arrival is 6:15AM at your assigned polling location. Pollworkers are provided a 2 hour lunch scheduled by the Precinct Warden. Pollworkers are required to stay until ballots are processed at the end of the night at the precinct (9PM – 10PM usually, sometimes later.)

Payment is \$15 for training, \$5 for lunch, and \$135 for Inspectors (\$155 total) and \$155 for Wardens/Clerks (\$170 total).
