Call to order at 3:34PM

Minutes of Feb 8 2016 approved on motion by Patrick Driscoll, seconded by Bob DesMarais-unanimous

Discussion about the closure of Hunking School and its unavailability this fall. Need to move precincts 2-02 and 7-02. Linda had contacted Sacred Hearts and has not heard back. She and Frank Bernstein visited Northpoint and the administrators there were very accommodating. Decision to move 2-02 to Northpoint and 7-02 to Bradford Elementary School, so there will be 2 voting precincts at both locations. Vote to move – motion by Bob, seconded by Patrick, unanimous.

Further discussion-

Need lots of signage at Hunking location to alert voters to change of location in September and November. Linda will work on this and inform Tom Geary as well.

Bob would like us to consider using gym behind Sacred Heart school as future voting location. Linda will look into it. Also Bob would like us to consider Greenleaf School . Linda will check with school department and see if that is feasible.

In continuing discussion about future polling locations, Bob would like to see another prec, subprec, at HW garage on Primrose St to accommodate voters from Primrose Way. Not enough parking and too far for them to vote at Washington Sq. which is their current location. Linda will investigate this as well.

2020 census. We had as prelim discussion about possible changes for precincts. Bob would like Mike LaBonte contacted when redrawing prec lines occurs.

Will schedule another meeting in couple weeks before 9-8 election.
