Attorney Paul Magliochetti appeared on behalf of the Licensee. Lt. Robert Pistone of the Haverhill Police department summarized the report, as this is a continuation of the hearing from December 2014. The parties have been drinking since 1:00 in the afternoon. The behavior in this matter was clearly fueled by intoxicated parties. Officers Ingham and Bailey of the Haverhill Police Department testified as the responding officers. The parties have been drinking since 1:00 in the afternoon. The behavior in this matter was clearly fueled by intoxicated parties. Attorney Magliochetti represented the establishment. He indicated that the report was clear and succinct. The Haverhill Police Department handled the incident well. However, nothing happened on the premises. The entire incident happened in the parking lot across the street. The establishment admits that the parties were drinking in the bar and they shut them off. The parties left for 20-30 minutes. The bartender coming on duty was told not to serve the people and when they came back, they were not served again. They were offered food and non-alcoholic beverages. The defendant was out of the bar from 6:00 to 7:25. Another patron left the bar and went to the car to defend the bartender. The defendant had been knocked out and when she

came to she was very belligerent, indicating that she was on more than just alcohol. Michelle Moran, the bartender at Kelly's testified first. William Donovan, a maintenance worker at the establishment, testified as a witness to the altercation. Jeff Moriarty, employee of Kelly's, also testified. He was the bartender on duty from 1:00 to 5:15. Joyce Moriarty, owner also testified. The Commission questioned the various witnesses as to the amount of alcohol consumed by the defendant, the location of the parties, the intoxication level of the parties and the witnesses, TIPS certifications of all the parties involved in serving the defendant, if the defendant was a known person to the servers and if there are cameras in the establishment. Chairman Edwards indicated that the amount of alcohol served to these parties was excessive and they should have been shut off before becoming intoxicated. Commissioner Sewell indicated that the events did take place in Kelly's, as that is where the drinking took place and there was no evidence of drinking elsewhere. Chairman Edwards indicated that there may be something missing from the complaint that over serving is clearly the violation. Commissioner Coco stated that the illegality is over serving. Commissioner Sewell made a motion to take no action. There was no second to the motion, motion failed. Attorney Magliochetti indicated that this was a learning experience for his client. That they would work with the City, draft a procedural manual for the workers and work with the police department. Commissioner Coco made a motion to require early closing at 9:00 PM on two consecutive Saturdays, starting on January 10<sup>th</sup> and January 17<sup>th</sup>, and all patrons to be out by 9:00 PM, seconded by Chairman Edwards. Attorney Magliochetti asked the Commission to reconsider. Vote – Two yeas, one nay – motion passed.
