APPROVAL OF THE HEALTH INSPECTOR AND RECEIPT OF BUSINESS OCCUPANCY PERMIT, IF APPROVED, LICENSE WILL ISSUE AFTER RECEIPT OF APPROVAL BY THE ABCC, RECEIPT OF LIQUOR LIABILITY INSURANCE INCLUDING OUTDOOR DINING INSURANCE, RECEIPT OF SAFE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL CERTIFICATES FOR ALL HANDLERS OF ALCOHOL, RECEIPT OF FIRE SAFETY CERTIFICATE (304 INSPECTION), RECEIPT OF LICENSE FEE AND RECEIPT OF CROWD CONTROL CERTIFICATE**

Attorney Tim Connors, Stephen Santoro and Bernard Goulet were all present. Attorney Tim Connors presented information on the applicants. Commissioner Coco asked about the experience of the LLC Managers. One of them is the manager of the Claddagh in Lawrence. The other was a co-owner of an establishment in Nashua, NH, but is from Haverhill and would like to be closer. They plan on opening as soon as the license is approved. Commissioner Sewell also inquired about experience and problems in the past, which were none. Commissioner Sewell also asked about the entertainment requested on the entertainment license application. Ken Shiff, a property owner in the neighborhood, appeared to ask questions about the parking in the area. On motion of Commissioner Coco, seconded by Commissioner Sewell, a recess was called for the parties to discuss this issue. Upon return, Attorney Connors indicated that the parties could come to a mutual agreement about the parking. Motion to approve the application subject to receipt by the License Commission Clerk of an agreement signed by the two parties regarding the parking, to approve the Common Victualler's License subject to approval of the Health Inspector and receipt of the building occupancy permit made by Commissioner Sewell, seconded by Commissioner Coco. Ken Shiff, a property owner in the neighborhood raised questions about the parking, but was ultimately in favor of the application. Vote two yeas, one absent, motion passed.
