Attorney Diane Faucon represented Sanjay Patel, who was also present. Lt. Robert Pistone from the Haverhill Police Department summarized the police report on the incident. Chairman Edwards stated that this was a new employee who was also new to the business of selling alcohol. He recommended to the manager that he needs to educate his employees on safe alcohol sales. Lt. Pistone indicated that the store cooperates with the police and the police department has been cracking down in this area. Manager stated there are cameras outside the store.

Attorney Faucon stated that Ms. Patel (the employee who made the sale) does not work alone anymore. Through unforeseen circumstances this night, she was alone for a brief amount of time. It was the inexperience of the clerk that led to this sale and steps have been taken to insure this type of sale won't happen again. Commissioner Sewell stated that all excuses are null and void. The clerk should not be working if inexperienced. It may be an honest mistake, but it is a violation due to lack of management. Commissioner Coco stated that with two prior violations, because this could have been more serious, he would recommend probation for six months and training for all employees. Motion by Commissioner Sewell for probation for a six month period, with training for all employees. If there is a further conviction within the six month period, will impose a separate punishment for the new violation and an early closing on a Friday and Saturday night at 9:00 pm, seconded by Commissioner Coco. No public comment on the matter. Vote unanimous – motion passed.
