Dear Mr. President and Members of the Haverhill City Council:

In our commitment to support the development of the downtown Harbor Place Project, it is necessary to consider a variety of options to help bring the project to fruition. One possibility is that we consider leasing spaces in the Goecke parking deck on Merrimack Street to prospective occupants of the proposed new buildings on Merrimack Street.

Before we can do that we are required to declare spaces "surplus", and then issue an RFP.

We are requesting the city council to declare 100 spaces in the Goecke Parking Garage to be "surplus" pursuant to chapter 30B thereby creating the option make these spaces available by RFP. "Surplus" does not mean that we do not need them or that we are disposing of them, it is simply a legal means of allowing the city to issue an RFP to lease spaces.

This order to declare areas "surplus" goes with another agenda item I am placing on for Tuesday night to appropriate \$5000 for a parking consultant. I am requesting a consultant in order to make certain that any plan we come up with is an integrated plan that takes into account the proposed new development on Merrimack Street as well as the existing Merrimack Street businesses.

I am enclosing an order to declare these areas surplus. I request approval.





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
