The following items were discussed:

- 1) **Document #10-J** – Communication from Councillor LePage requesting to discuss tag days. *Per the recommendation of the Police Chief, the Committee decided not to allow the locations of River Street and Upper Main Street on the Tag Day list and will not be considered locations in the future. Other sites that the veterans may suggest will be reviewed by the Chief. Solicitor Cox will be asked to update the ordinance.*

- 2) **Document #10-J** – Communication from Councillor McGonagle requesting to introduce a representative from Haverhill Fire Dept. Safety Committee to give status update on rescue truck. *A detailed Power Point presentation was given by the Safety Committee. Chiefs DeNaro and Borden and the Safety Committee expressed the need for a state of the art Rescue Truck. This information will be used during the upcoming FY16 budget sessions. **
