
**Recommendation:**

After review of the Central Business District Parking map by the Central Business District Parking Commission, City staff and the City parking consultant, it is proposed to make the following parking map and ordinance changes:

- *Bailey Boulevard* - As you know, the City has previously installed back-in- angle parking along a section of Bailey Blvd in an effort to increase the number of parking spaces. To continue to provide more parking spaces we recommend installing additional back-in- angle parking on the south side of Bailey Blvd, from West Street to Haverhill Place.
- *Haverhill Place Parking lot* - To continue to provide additional parking spaces in the Central Business District we recommend creating an additional 21 permit parking spaces in the Haverhill Place Parking lot. This would be accomplished by expanding the existing parking lot.

Attached please find a copy of the map with the proposed parking changes illustrated. Representative(s) of the Parking Commission plan can attend an upcoming City Council meeting to further explain these proposed changes if needed.

Whereas, Seventy years ago, the soldiers, sailors, and airmen of the Allied Expeditionary Force invaded Normandy in northern France resulting in the liberation of Western Europe from Nazi Germany's control. Codenamed Operation Overlord, the battle began on June 6, 1944, also known as D-Day, when some 156,000 American, British and Canadian forces landed on five beaches along a 50-mile stretch of the heavily fortified coast of France's Normandy region, and

Whereas, The invasion was one of the largest amphibious military assaults in history and required extensive planning. The courage of these troops turned the tide of World War II and changed the fate of the world forever. Their extraordinary service in the face of great danger demonstrated the finest qualities of our Nation and of our Allies, and millions around the world today live in freedom because of their sacrifice, and

Whereas, Numerous Haverhill men served in that history amphibious landing at Normandy seventy years ago today, and

Whereas, Two of those Haverhill men remain with us today, Ray Jenkins and Edwin Girroir, and


