RE: Transfer Order

Mr. President and members of the City Council:

Enclosed is a transfer order to transfer \$2,500 from General Fund Budget Reserve to the General Fund Account, Police Department Expense. This transfer is to fund our new "Gun Buy Back Program" which will take place on November 15th from 6:30 – 11PM at the Citizens Center. We are working, through the Police Department, to collect as many firearms as possible that people will bring. Removing firearms would cut down guns that could be stolen in robberies and also protect children from accidents with guns.
