Mayor Continues to Implement Capital Improvements at City Hall

HAVERHILL- Today, Mayor James J. Fiorentini announced that he is continuing the capital improvements needed at city hall. The Mayor shared a copy of the Capital Improvement Plans with the city council last week. The council approved the transfer needed to continue capital improvements at city hall. The items to be addressed are the eaves at the top of the building; they will be painted and sanded at a cost of \$55,000. The next item to be addressed is the retaining wall in the parking lot. There will be engineering and design work for a cost of \$60,000. The next item is replacing some carpeting in various offices; the cost of the carpeting will be \$10,000.

Mayor Fiorentini said:

“It is important to maintain our historic city hall. Residents need a reliable place to visit to do their city business.

“City hall is only a piece of our Capital Improvement Plan, we plan to do many other needed repairs around the city, including snow plow equipment needed to keep our roadways clear and safe for our residents during snow storms.”
