## **Mayor Fiorentini Announces Extreme Snow Emergency**

Today, Mayor James J. Fiorentini announced an Extreme Snow Emergency for the City starting tonight, January 26th, at 6PM through Wednesday, January 28th, 6PM.

The streets need to be cleared for safety. Parking is NOT permitted on any City street. There are municipal lots available for parking including the Haverhill Public Library, all School parking lots, Somebody Cares New England, located at 358 Washington Street, All Saints Church, 120 Bellevue Ave. and City Hall. A shuttle will be provided at no charge for the residents who decide to park at the Tilton School, 70 Grove Street, from 6PM to 9PM tonight only.

The MVRTA Garage and the Goeke Parking Deck are also available.

Please note that there is NO trash or recycling pickup on Tuesday and Wednesday. If your trash/recycling day is scheduled for Tuesday it will be picked up on Thursday. If your day is scheduled on Wednesday, it will be picked up on Friday. Thursday and Friday trash/recycling will be picked up on Saturday. The Recycling yard will be closed on Wednesday. If you are in need of shelter please call the Police Department at 978-373-1212 and arrangements will be made to open the Citizen's Center.

In addition, Superintendent Scully has canceled school for Tuesday, January 27th and Wednesday, January 28th.

Mayor Fiorentini stated, "I encourage residents to help each other out and where possible, please share your driveways. It's critical to keep the streets cleared for emergencies and DPW".
