Mayor Dedicates Bench in Memory of Deputy Chief Robert W. Buckley, Jr

Today, Mayor James J. Fiorentini dedicated a bench in memory of Deputy Fire Chief Robert W. Buckley, Jr. The Mayor was joined by Buckley's widow, Angela Buckley. Mrs. Buckley purchased the bench and wanted it to be placed in Bradford Common, she wanted people to be able to sit on the bench to enjoy the music on the common. Deputy Fire Chief Buckley rose through the ranks after being appointed to the Haverhill Fire Department in September 1985. In 1989, he was promoted to Lieutenant, in 1993 he was promoted to Captain and in 2002, he was promoted to Deputy Chief. In May of 2010, Deputy Chief Buckley retired from the fire department. The Deputy Chief was a committed firefighter, he enjoyed taking his son to Red Sox games and would often be seen at his camp up north relaxing on his time off.
