MAYOR FIORENTINI DEDICATES BENCH TO JENNIFER BELL

On Friday, July 19th at 4PM, Mayor James J. Fiorentini will be dedicating a memorial bench to Jennifer Bell at the George Washington Landing Park located on Ferry St. in Bradford. This is part of the City's memorial bench program. Jennifer's sister Ashley Bell contacted the Mayor's office a while back to find out how to dedicate a bench to her beloved sister. Ashley, her parents and other family, as well as many of Jennifer's friends, will be present for the dedication.

Jennifer Bell was born in October 1980 in Haverhill to Wayne and Pamela Bell of Bradford. On November 4, 1997, Jennifer was killed by a freight train while she was crossing the walking on railroad tracks over the Merrimack River, using it as a shortcut. She was a senior at Whittier Vocational Technical High School studying graphic arts and planned on attending Suffolk University after graduation.
