MAYOR FIORENTINI ANNOUNCES PUBLIC MEETING FOR BRADFORD RAIL-TRAIL

HAVERHILL- Mayor James J. Fiorentini announced that the Massachusetts Department of Transportation Highway Division will be conducting a Public Hearing on the official 25% Design submission for the Bradford Rail Trail Project on **Wednesday night, February 12 at 7:00PM in Haverhill City Hall Room #301.**

At this hearing, the City's design firm, Stantec, will be presenting the details of its 25% design for the 3,000 foot-long non-vehicular path to be constructed from land the City bought from the Pan Am Railroad. The site runs from the Basiliere Bridge westward towards the Comeau Bridge along the Merrimack River opposite Downtown Haverhill.

“This hearing presents a great opportunity for the public to become acquainted with this exciting project, which will help transform the riverfront area of Haverhill,” Mayor James J. Fiorentini announced.

“I would encourage all neighbors, abutters, potential users and interested citizens to attend,” the Mayor added.

This public hearing is a required element of the process of getting the Rail-Trail designed and approved for construction in Federal Fiscal Year 2014.
