## **Mayor Provides Enhanced Bus Service for Haverhill Residents**

Today, Mayor James J. Fiorentini announced that the enhanced bus service that he approved in the spring started as of September 8<sup>th</sup>. This service change enhances the weekday bus service from 90 minutes to every 60 minutes. The Mayor also had previously approved Sunday service, which is currently available to residents. There is no change of service to the weekends due to the enhanced weekday service.

The MVRTA runs 5 routes serviced by 4 buses. They service Haverhill and 13 other communities in the Merrimack Valley. They operate Monday through Friday from 6AM until 6PM. The Saturday and Sunday service runs from 8AM until 6PM. The MVRTA also runs 16 vans for all of their communities for the elderly and disabled with a one day advance notice.
