Lt. Robert Pistone and Officer Kevin Lynch were in attendance for the police department. Sohan Saini represented American Grocery. Rakesh Rana, the clerk, was also in attendance. Chairman Edwards admonished Mr. Saini to have appropriate signage in the store and train his people about selling to intoxicated persons. The clerk indicated the person was a repeat customer and walks with a limp and he was unable to determine if the person was intoxicated. Commissioner Sewell indicated that there was sufficient information to find cause, especially since there were two violations in a short time. Commissioner Coco indicated the resolution to recent similar violations is probation. Commission Sewell made a motion to place the establishment on probation for six (6) months, in the event of reoccurrence of any type; the Commission will close down two nights – Friday and Saturday at 7:00 PM plus any other penalty for the new violation. Motion seconded by Commissioner Coco. Lt. Pistone indicated that probation would be too lenient a penalty. Commissioner Sewell made a motion to amend his original motion to include training for all employees in the safety of serving alcohol to be completed in the next three (3) months, seconded by Commissioner Coco. There was no public comment on this matter. Vote two yeas, one present – Motion, as amended passed.
