**Summary:** Andrew Pojasek from Dana F. Perkins Inc. gave a project update. TW asked how wide the bridge is – AP said about 35'. TW asked if it will be two lanes – AP said yes. AP discussed the wetland replication areas/size. AP confirmed the tanker trucks will be empty with no fuel. FC read comments/recommendations from RM.

**Action:** LD made a motion to issue an OOC approving this project to include all comments read into the record from RM. Seconded by OA. Clerk called role: OA-yes, LD-yes, JR-abstain, TW-yes, FC-yes. Motion passed 4-1-2. Approved.

**Summary:** Matt Corbin (Engineer from Wright Pierce Engineering) located at 27 Leah Circle in Methuen, MA was present, as well as Paul Jessel (Collections Supervisor) from 48 Old Yankee Road and Chuck Heron (Environmental Scientist) from 247 Branch Hill Road Westminster, MA. MC gave a project overview. LD asked if it is upstream from the damn and CH said yes. TW asked how far upstream from the damn are they – maybe a quarter mile. TW asked when this will happen – goal is the fall/spring. FC read comments/recommendations from RM. TW asked about an increase in flow – MC said at the 10-year storm it could be up to 7 to 8 MGD. PJ asked if they have to put hoods in because it is very hard to clean the catch basins with them. FC said it is a recommended condition. MC said they can add an addendum because it is still out to bid. There is a pre-construction meeting next week where all of these questions will be answered.

## **2.4. #33-1585 Boston Gas Company for Lake Street ROW Installation of new gas main**

**Summary:** Sam Kefferstan (from BSC Group) from 311 River Street in Cambridge, MA gave a project overview. LD asked SF to review what the horizontal directional rule is? SF explained. SF also explained how there is an attached contingency plan that contains all the details on how they would respond if there was a release of the fluid. SK said they usually go 5' below grade – OA asked why they are going 12' below? SK said that was determined by the crew. SK said he can get back to them on why. LD asked what the material of the culvert is and SK didn't know. LD said they are probably going that low because of the culvert. FC asked what the diameter of the hole is? SK said it is a 6" main. SK said the material can be put off to the side and then they can use it for backfill. LD asked how many service connections – SK said 2. OA asked if they hit the water table when they are doing the preparation. He said they have bmp's in place for dewatering if necessary. OA asked how long the pipe is – 3k'. Anora from BSC Group located at 63 Woodhawk Drive in Milford, NH said the trench is usually 3' x 3' wide. The depth was determined from ground pressure radar. LD asked them to get back to the Commission because she thought the radar could only go 5-7'. TW asked about start date – summer of 2025. FC read comments/recommendations from RM and he also added that the Commission would like to know how far the depth of the radar can go prior to giving an OOC.

**Action:** LD made a motion to issue an OOC with the items that are outstanding to include all comments read into the record from RM. Seconded by OA. Clerk called role: OA-yes, LD-yes, JR-yes, TW-yes, FC-yes. Motion passed 5-0-2. Approved.

## **5. ENFORCEMENT**

**5.1. Enforcement Order:** 230 Forest Street, Karen Puglielli – Issued May 7<sup>th</sup> for the “excavation of soil and the installation of an underdrain within a bordering vegetated wetland.”

**Summary:** FC read comments from RM. Keith Brown (the handyman), Theo (a friend), Kathy and Karen (residents at property) were present. The homeowner stated that she had no idea that there were wetlands there and she wished she was informed of this prior. She doesn't think it is fair that she has to pay for a wetland scientist to come out. Keith Brown explained the work that he performed and he said he was restoring back to how it used to be. Keith said he only has one missed call and he was willing to meet RM at 9 am. The conclusion was that Kathy and Karen were going to get a list of wetland scientists and try to contact them to schedule a delineation, and then they can further discuss. FC read recommendations from RM.

**Action:** LD moved that they move this enforcement order to the June 26<sup>th</sup> meeting, McKayla will get the list of wetland scientists to Karen and Kathy. Seconded by JR. Clerk called role: OA-abstain, LD-yes, JR-yes, TW-yes, FC-yes. Motion passed 4-1-2. Approved.

Summary: FC read comments/recommendations from RM. TW asked MA if there is an update, MA said he has not been able to get a wetland consultant and he said they are all too busy. JR asked how much additional time is needed. TW and FC said they are not sure.
