**CHAPTER 240** 

An Ordinance Relating to Vehicles and Traffic Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Haverhill that the Code of the City of Haverhill, Chapter 240, §108. Schedule: Central Business District Parking Fees, Rates and Terms, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

By adding the following at the end of the section "NOTES: \*\*Permit parking.....".

"The residents of 1 Water Street shall be considered residents of the Central Business District solely for the purposes of purchasing parking permits for use of the Herbert H. Goecke, Jr Parking Deck." (see document for complete text)
