HOME RULE PETITION

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF AT LARGE AND WARD SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEMBERS IN THE CITY OF HAVERHILL.

Be it enacted, etc. as follows:

SECTION 1. School Committee. Notwithstanding chapter 43 of the General Laws or any other general or special law or rule, regulation or ordinance to the contrary, there shall be in the city of Haverhill a school committee of 9 members, which committee shall have all the rights, powers and duties of a school committee as provided by the general laws, this act, the city charter, or any amendments thereto. The mayor shall serve, in an ex officio capacity, as chairperson of the school committee, with a voice and a vote. Each other member shall be elected for a term of 2 years: 3 school committee member shall be elected at large by the voters of the city and 5 school committee member shall be elected from each district of the city, which district shall be defined in the ordinances of the city.

SECTION 2. Nomination. (a) School Committee Member At Large. An individual seeking to be elected as school committee member at large shall be a resident and registered voter of the city on the date they take out nomination papers for the office and at all times thereafter. Nomination papers for school committee member at large shall be signed by no less than 50 registered voters of the city. (b) District School Committee Member. An individual seeking election as a district school committee member shall be a resident and registered voter of the city, and that district, on the date they take out nomination papers for the office and at all times thereafter, except as



provided for in Section 3 below. Nomination papers for district school committee member shall be signed by no less than 25 registered voters of the district from which the individual seeks to be elected.

SECTION 3. Removal from City or District. A school committee member at large or district school committee member that removes from the city during their elected term shall be deemed by the city clerk to have vacated their office. A district school committee member that moves from one district to another during the first 18 months of the elected term shall be deemed to have vacated their seat, however, a district school committee member who removes from the district from which they were elected during the last six months of the elected term may complete their term as district school committee member.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon passage, and the offices of eight school committee members, 7 district school committee members, and 1 school committee member at large shall appear on the ballot at the 2021 biennial city election. Nomination papers shall differentiate between school committee member at large and district school committee member, and shall be furnished by the city clerk to individuals requesting the same. All incumbent elected school committee members holding office as of the effective date of this act who submit nomination papers for election to any position on the school committee at such 2021 biennial city election shall be entitled to have the words "candidate for re-nomination" or "candidate for re-election" appear next to their name on the ballot."

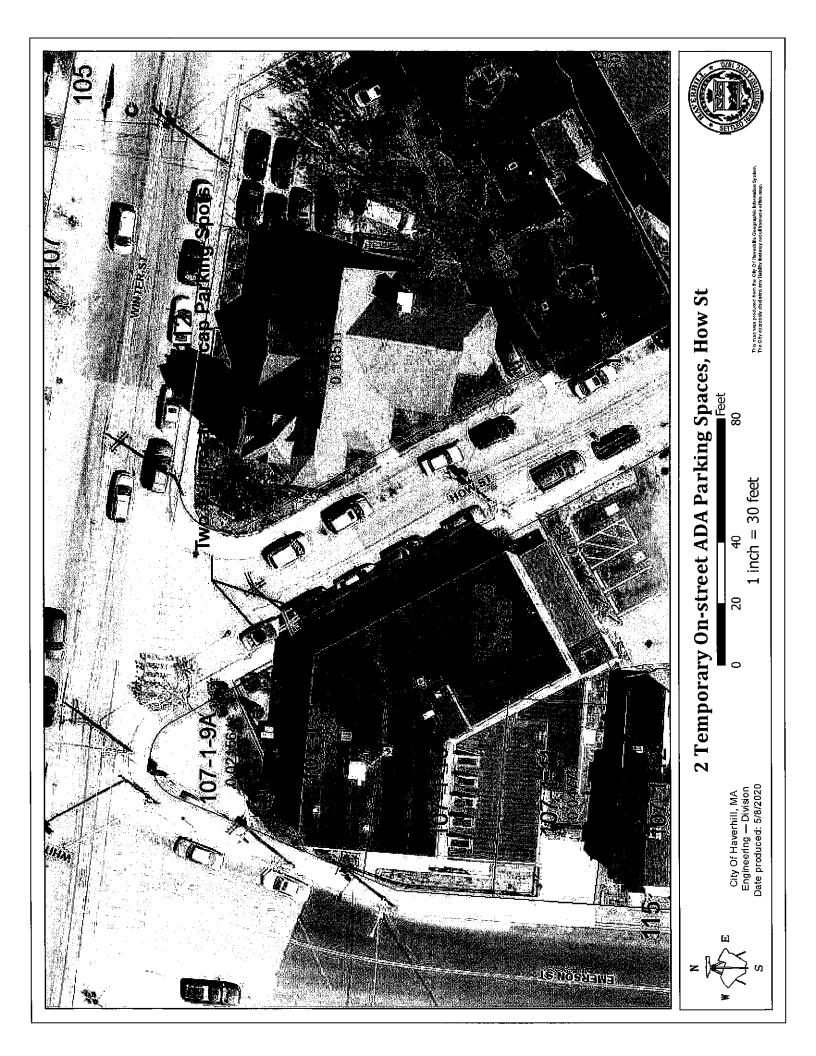

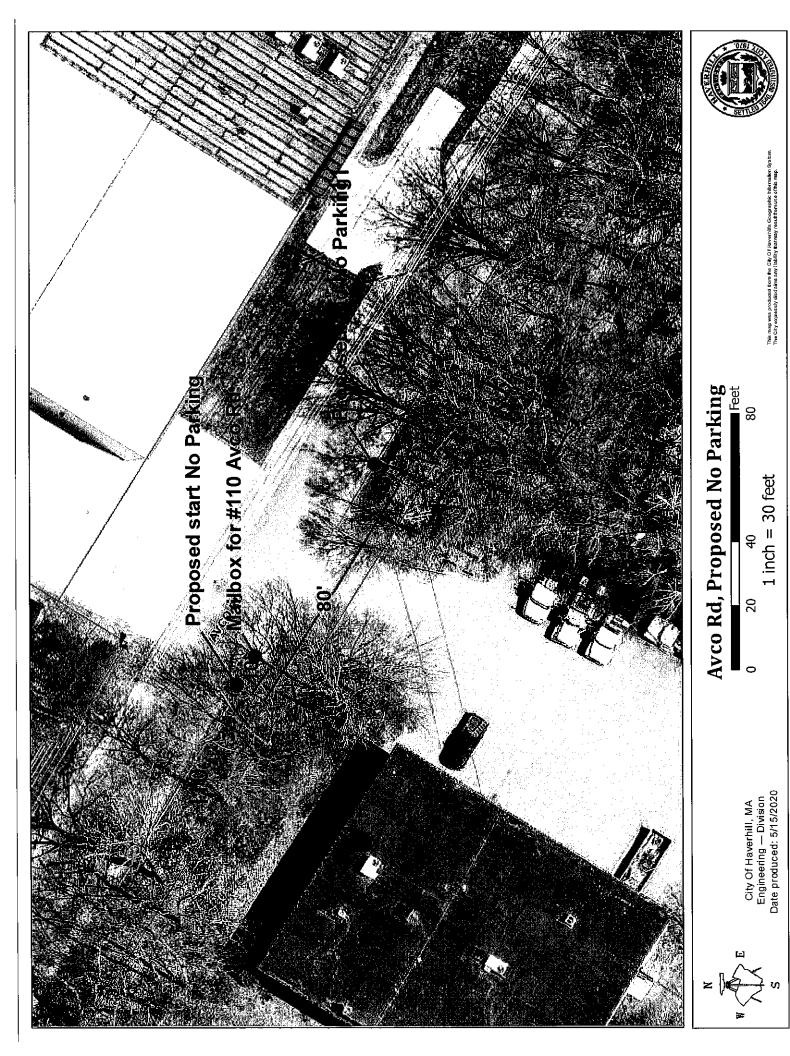

I recommend that this matter be tabled until the March 31 City Council meeting and be scheduled for a vote at that time.

I know there is also been some discussion about other matters such as ward School Committee members before the public. While I am certainly open to discussing this with the City Council and to having public discussion about this, it is my feeling that if we decide to go with other ballot initiatives that they should be on the municipal ballot next year. These matters are more complex and require planning and discussion. If the Council would prefer to have that discussion this year and if there is a Council desire to put that on the ballot this year I am certainly open to discussing and working with the Council on that.

HOME RULE PETITION

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF AT LARGE AND WARD COUNCILORS IN THE CITY OF HAVERHILL.

Be it enacted, etc. as follows:

SECTION 1. City Council. Notwithstanding chapter 43 of the General Laws or any other general or special law or rule, regulation or ordinance to the contrary, there shall be in the city of Haverhill a city council of 11 members, which council shall have all the rights, powers and duties of the city except as otherwise provided by the general laws, this act, the city charter, or any amendments thereto. Each councilor shall be elected for a term of 2 years: 4 councilors shall be elected at large by the voters of the entire city and 1 councilor shall be elected from each district of the city of Haverhill, which district shall be one ward, or otherwise, as defined in the ordinances of the city.

SECTION 2. Nomination. (a) Councilor at large. An individual seeking to be elected as councilor at large shall be a resident and registered voter of the city on the date they take out nomination papers for the office and at all times thereafter. Nomination papers for councilor at large shall be signed by no less than 50 registered voters of the city. (b) District Councilor. An individual seeking election as a district councilor shall be a resident and registered voter of the city and that district, on the date they take out nomination papers for the office and at all times thereafter, except as provided for in Section 3 below. Nomination papers for district councilor shall be signed by no less than 25 registered voters of the district from which the individual seeks to be elected.

SECTION 3. Removal from City or Ward. A councilor at large or district councilor that removes from the city during their elected term shall be deemed by the city clerk to have vacated their office. A district councilor that moves from one ward to another during the first 18 months of the elected term shall be deemed to have vacated their seat, however, a district councilor who removes from the district from which they were elected during the last six months of the elected term may complete their term as district councilor.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon passage, and the offices of four councilors at large and seven ward councilors shall appear on the ballot at the 2021 biennial city election. Nomination papers shall differentiate between councilor at large and district councilor, and shall be furnished by the city clerk to individuals requesting the same. All incumbent elected councilors who submit nomination papers for election to any position on the city council at such 2021 biennial city election shall be entitled to have the words "candidate for re-nomination" or "candidate for re-election" appear next to their name on the ballot."

MINUTES OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES & PUBLIC PROPERTY COMMITTEE MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 27, 2020

A Natural Resources and Public Property Committee meeting was held on Thursday, Feb. 27, 2020 at 7:00P.M. in the City Council office, Room 204.

Committee Members: Councillor Sullivan, Chairperson and Councillors LePage and Bevilacqua. President Barrett also attended.

Attendees: Michael Sexton, Alyssa Sexton, David P. LaBrode, and Betsey Guest-Natale.

1) **Doc.** #11-S-Communication from Councilor Sullivan requesting a discussion regarding a property owner's request to lease or purchase City Land (Whittier Rd., Map 440, Bl.2, Lot 1A) abutting their property at 256 Whittier Road.

The Chair reviewed with the members of the Committee and the requestors, Michael & Alyssa Sexton, their request to lease or purchase up to 3 acres of public land that abuts the back of their property. Per usual practice, department heads were required to submit their comments and recommendations as to the request. The two key departments responding in opposition to any lease or purchase were Health & Inspections/Conservation and the Water Department. Both related similar thoughts that the area in question along with a larger swath of land was purchased back in 1998 for public drinking water supply protection as the property is within the watershed protection district of Millvale Reservoir. Millvale Reservoir provides approximately 70+ percent of the city's annual drinking water supply. Water is pumped from Millvale Reservoir to Kenoza Lake. Rob Moore, Environmental Health Technician submitted further comments that he reviewed aerial images showing that a portion of the protected land may be being used for farming purposes. The Sexton's assured the Committee that they have not been using any of the public land, and I affirmed that fact as I had visited the Sexton property before the meeting. Councillor Bevilacqua noted that we seldom if ever go against our Department Head recommendations, and Councillor LePage and I agreed that we could not support pursuing further the sale or lease of the portion of public land in question. The Sexton's agreed that it would not be in their best interests to pursue further and asked to withdraw their petition without prejudice. Councillor Bevilacqua made a motion to that effect, seconded by Councilor LePage and the motion passed 3-0. It was also noted that we would send a letter to the Mayor, City Engineer, and City Solicitor informing them that someone in the area has been farming a larger portion of public land, but not abutting the Sexton property, for further investigation.

The following Committee Study List documents were reviewed for update and/or disposition:

1) Doc.#93-L/18-Communication from President Michitson requesting to introduce Dave LaBrode to discuss street tree plantings.

The Chair introduced Dave LaBrode, who had been appointed to the Mayor's new "Tree Committee", for the purpose of determining whether or not the Committee had met yet. It was determined that the Committee had not yet met. While with us in Committee, members asked Dave for his assessment of the results thus far of the recent tree plantings. He believes the trees are being planted more properly, but mentioned that sidewalk replacements continue to occur in the Highlands neighborhood without replacing or creating any new tree pits. He also expressed concern for the status of older trees and noted that sidewalks throughout the Highlands have been compromised by overgrown trees and roots, including Arlington Street, Park Street, and Webster Street, as well as in other areas of the city, including White Street, Welcome Street, Summer Street, and Ginty Boulevard. Councillor Bevilacqua thanked Dave for his valuable input and for his ongoing advocacy of public trees and park benches. Subject turned back to the status of the "Tree Committee" and as a result of no known action by the Mayor to convene the Tree Committee, Councillor LePage made a motion requesting an update on the status of the work of the "Tree Committee" as well as an update on the status of 2019 tree plantings and anticipated 2020 tree plantings. The motion was seconded by Councillor Bevilacqua, and the motion passed 3-0. As such this item will remain on the committee long term study list.

2) Doc. #38-J-Communication from Councillor Macek requesting a discussion about reserve parking spaces at City Hall designated for Registry of Motor Vehicles.

The Chair gave an update to the Committee that he received a response from the Mayor's Chief of Staff, Allison Heartquist, that the matter is under advisement, but also on hold due to anticipated re-construction of the retaining wall in back of City Hall as well as related work planned in that immediate area. As no action will be taken by the Mayor during this time, the item will remain on the committee long term study list.

3) Doc.#79F-Communication from Councillor Sullivan requesting to introduce Kathleen Fitts, Gale Park Association, to request the city replace the Gale Park Fountain in fiscal year '20.

The Chair introduced Betsy Natale representing the Gale Park Neighborhood Association to give an update on the status of replacing the Gale Park Fountain. Betsy explained that since they came before us, they obtained three different proposals for replacement fountains, and believe that Specialty Fountain & Waterscape, Inc. based out of Duluth, GA was the best choice. She further explained that the Association has chosen a 22' Diameter Round Fountain having an Iron Caesar Three Tier fountain. She showed member a photo of the Caesar Fountain and members commented favorably on the look. The Chair said it fits with the rest of the Park and the general area. Betsy explained that the cost of the Fountain is \$72,500.00 and projected the ground preparation and base installation/reconstruction will cost approximately \$25,000.00. Discussion turned to how to raise the approximately \$100,000.00 to complete this project. Betsy mentioned soliciting donations from member of the Association as well as the public in general. As for the

city's contribution, Councillor Bevilacqua and LePage both suggested that perhaps the City could cover the ground preparation/base installation cost portion of the project, and the rest of the funds would have to be raised by the proponents. Councillor Bevilacqua recommended that a meeting be set up with the Mayor and the Gale Park Neighborhood Association to ascertain the city's level of commitment to the fountain replacement project. Councillor LePage questioned if the City could do the preparation work in house, or if an outside company would need to be brought in. Betsy said Triad Systems does this work and may be familiar with the current fountain at Gale Park.

A motion was made by Councillor Bevilacqua to send a letter to the Mayor asking him to arrange a meeting with the Gale Park Neighborhood Association to further advance the discussion to replace the fountain. The motion was seconded by Councillor LePage, and the item passed 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 7:42pm upon motion of Councillor Bevilacqua, seconded by Councillor LePage, and passed 3-0.
