## Investment Consultant Review & Update Report

- Overview of Markets and Performance Report
- Wainwright Investment Counsel provided a market update as of July 7, 2020 and a
  performance update through May 2020. The effects of the COVID-19 crisis on the capital
  markets were among the topics discussed.
- 2. Wainwright Investment Counsel provided a rebalancing report as of July 7, 2020. Wainwright Investment Counsel reminded the client that the valuations used for rebalancing purposes are the most recent valuations available from People's United Bank and that those valuations will be different from the valuations ultimately reported by Massachusetts Pension Reserves Investment Management (PRIT).
- 3. Wainwright Investment Counsel provided a pro forma rebalancing report as of July 7, 2020 to include two expected appropriations: \$11.2 mm in July and \$10.0 mm in August. The Board approved allocating \$8.5 mm from the July appropriation to the Massachusetts Pension Reserves Investment Management (PRIT) General Allocation Fund. The following \$2.7 mm will be used to cover benefit payments.
- 4. Wainwright Investment Counsel provided preliminary performance for Putnam Investments and Fisher Investments as of June 30, 2020.
