UNLOCK COVER


Using the set of keys provided, unlock the locks on both the left and right side of the ballot box cover. Then remove the cover.






Open the power cord cover on top of the ballot box. Uncoil the cord, press it into the channel, and plug into a surge protector. Close the


power cord cover.



S INSPECT MAIN COMPARTMENT


Unlock the main compartment access door (lock #3), open the door by sliding it to the left, and inspect the compartment to ensure no ballots are present.






INSPECT WRITE-IN COMPARTMENT


Open the white write-in access door by pushing up about an inch until it hits the top stop and allow the door to swing open. Inspect the compartment to ensure no ballots are present.





5 SECURE COMPARTMENTS


Secure the write-in access door by lifting and dropping it back into place. Slide the main compartment access door closed and lock it.






INSPECT HAND COUNT COMPARTMENT

Unlock the hand count compartment access door (lock #4) at the rear of the ballot box, lift the cover, and ensure no ballots are present. Push up on the tab inside the cover to open the ballot slot. Close and lock the compartment.









UNLOCK TABULATOR LATCH


Unlock the tabulator lock cover (#6) to the right of the ballot path and open it to reveal the latch. Lift the latch to the open position.






S ATTACH TABULATOR

Remove the ImageCast tabulator from its carry case and place it on the ballot box by lining up the rubber legs on the bottom of the machine with the grooves on the tabulator shelf.







S) CONNECT POWER

Once the legs are in place, slide the machine three quarters of the way toward the back of the ballot box.


Plug the power cord (located on the left side of the ballot path) into the AC power port at the back of the tabulator.






LOCK TABULATOR


Slide the ImageCast unit the rest of the way so that it is flush with the opening of the ballot path. Hook the lock latch onto the bracket at the back of the tabulator to secure the unit. Then close and lock the cover (#6).





POWER ON TABULATOR


With the ImageCast tabulator now secured to the ballot box, power it on by using a pen or pencil to press and hold the power button on the front of the unit until it emits a series of 5 beeps.






APPLY SECURITY KEY


After about 60 seconds, the tabulator will instruct for the security key to be applied to the security key pad on the top left of the unit. Place and hold firmly until the password prompt appears. Remove the security key, enter the key password, and press "Enter".





AUTHENTICATE ELECTION FILES


After confirming the correct password, the tabulator will then begin authenticating the election files encrypted on the memory cards.

VERIFY SERIAL NUMBERS

While the election files are being authenticated, verify that the serial numbers on the seals around both memory card access doors match the serial numbers documented during pre-election testing.



15 VERIFY DATE & TIME

Once the election files are validated, a prompt will appear to confirm the date and time. If correct, press "Confirm".

If incorrect, press "Change" and follow the instructions on page 69 of this guide to correct.








PRINT ZERO REPORT

The tabulator will then immediately prompt you to print the Zero report. While the default selection will be 1 copy, refer to your specific municipality guidelines for the required number of copies.







The voter will insert his/her ballot into the ballot entry slot. The tabulator will then scan the ballot.




PURE BALLOT

CAST BALLOT

Once the tabulator determines it has scanned a valid ballot, it will cast the ballot and display a "Ballot Successfully Cast" message.

Once the ballot is securely in the ballot box, the screen will return to the "Please Insert Ballot" message and the ballot counter will have increased by 1.



OVERVOTED BALLOT

QUICK REVIEW

If the tabulator determines it has scanned a ballot with at least one overvoted contest, it will notify the voter of the exact contest(s) needing attention.

The voter can use the UP and DOWN arrows to scroll through the message.



OVERVOTED BALLOT

CAST/RETURN BALLOT

If the voter wishes to cast his/her ballot as is, he/she may press the green 'Cast' button below the LCD display screen. No votes will be recorded by the tabulator for the over-voted contest; however, any other contests with valid voter markings will be counted.

If the voter wishes to correct his/her ballot, he/she may press the red 'Return' button below the LCD screen to return the ballot for correction.






DURING THE POLLS BLANK BALLOT

QUICK REVIEW

If the tabulator determines it has scanned a ballot with no voter markings at all, it will notify the voter of the discrepancy.




DURING THE POLLS BLANK BALLOT

CAST/RETURN BALLOT

If the voter wishes to cast his/her ballot as is, he/she may press the green 'Cast' button below the LCD display screen. No votes will be recorded by the tabulator for any of the contests.

If the voter wishes to correct his/her ballot, he/she may press the red 'Return' button below the LCD screen to return the ballot for correction.






AMBIGUOUS MARK

QUICK REVIEW

If the tabulator determines it has scanned a ballot with one or more ambiguous marks—meaning the mark in the target voting area is not clear enough for the tabulator to be certain of the voter's intent—it will notify the voter.

The voter's only option is to press the red "Return" button below the LCD display screen to return their ballot.





CAST BALLOT

The voter can either clarify their existing ballot and re-insert it, or fill out a new ballot and insert it into the tabulator.

If the voter does not wish to do either, they may elect to place their ballot into the hand count compartment.



MISREAD BALLOT

QUICK REVIEW

If the tabulator determines it cannot read a ballot, it will notify the voter and return the ballot to the voter.


A ballot can be misread for a number of reasons: a fold or tear in the ballot, an incorrect ballot style, or a defect in the ballot's registration marks.




JAMMED BALLOT

ASSISTANCE REQUIRED

If a voter's ballot becomes jammed inside the tabulator, the voter will be prompted immediately to ask for the Poll Worker's assistance.

To see the details of the error, the Poll Worker must place the security key onto the security key pad of the tabulator.

JAMMED BALLOT - RESULTS NOT SAVED

2 RESULTS <u>NOT</u> SAVED

If the tabulator was not able to read, interpret, and tally the voter's ballot before it became jammed, a message will read "Results Have Not Been Saved".



If the tabulator **was** able to read, interpret, and tally the voter's ballot before it became jammed, a message will read "Results Have Been Saved".

The jammed ballot will need to be cleared from the ballot path and then placed in the appropriate compartment of the ballot box with the rest of the counted ballots.




EMPTY HAND COUNT COMPARTMENT

Once voting has ended, unlock the hand count compartment access door (lock #4), lift the cover, and remove all ballots. Push down on the tab inside the cover to close the ballot slot. Close and lock the compartment.







TALLY HAND COUNT BALLOTS

All ballots not able to be read by the tabulator must be given to an election official to hand count using a Tally Sheet to record the votes for each contest.

Taking care not to mix the write-in ballots with the ballots from the main compartment, open the white write-in access door and remove all ballots.






READ ERROR MESSAGE

If the tabulator encounters an error with the thermal printer, it will display a message on the LCD display screen.





OPEN PRINTER COVER

Open the printer cover on the top of the tabulator by squeezing the tab at the front of the cover and pulling up.






REMOVE BAR

Remove the metal bar from the printer compartment by gripping the bar and pulling up until it comes loose. Place it off to the side.



REPLACE PAPER

Remove the plastic rod from the compartment and feed it through the new roll of paper.






る REPLACE BAR

Place the new paper roll into the printer compartment, ensuring the paper is coming up from the bottom rather than over from the top.

Place the metal bar over the paper roll with the gear on the left side and push until it clicks back into place.

Be sure to leave about an inch of paper coming out to be fed through the opening of the printer cover.



CLOSE PRINTER COVER

Feed the end of the new paper roll through the opening of the printer cover and close the cover by pushing down on the top until it snaps into place.




CHECK PLUG

If the tabulator loses AC power, it will make the switch to battery power automatically. The internal battery can sustain the tabulator for up to 4 hours.

Battery power is indicated on the tabulator by the icon in the top right corner of the LCD display screen, as well as a solid orange light on the front left of the unit.


If you notice the tabulator has switched to battery power, check the power cord's connection to the power strip, the power strip's connection to the wall outlet, the power strip is on, and the wall outlet is live.




2 CHECK AC PORT

If the power cord is securely connected to the wall outlet, next check the cord's connection at the back of the tabulator.

First unlock the tabulator lock cover (#6) and unhook the latch from the bracket on the back of the tabulator.






CHECK AC PORT

Slide the tabulator forward away from the ballot path and make sure the cord is securely plugged in to the AC power port at the back of the tabulator.





Also confirm that there is no damage to the power cord.

CONTACT LHS

If both ends of the power cord are securely connected and the tabulator is still running on battery power, notify your local election official so they can submit a request for vendor services.
