The Department of Public Works, acting on behalf of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, after public notice and a hearing of all parties interested on February 4, 1959, as required by Chapter 218 of the Acts of 1937, hereby adjudges that public necessity and convenience require that the Commonwealth should lay out and take charge of, as a limited access State highway, a road in the City of Haverhill, County of Essex (Relocation of Route 110).

WHEREAS, in order to prove access between the City Easement Parcels, the City desires to obtain an easement to construct, install, operate, repair, use and maintain certain Improvements (as hereinafter defined) for access purposes between the City Easement Parcels on a portion of the Property shown as "ACCESS EASEMENT AREA" (hereinafter the "Easement Area") on that plan (the "Easement Plan") entitled: "EASEMENT EXHIBIT PLAN HAVERHILL LANDFILL—NORTHERN MOUND & LOT 26 ASH AREA HAVERHILL, MASSACHUSETTS, EX-1" Scale: 1"=20', Date:______, prepared by Langdon Environmental LLC of Portsmouth, NH, a reduced copy of which Easement Plan is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof. The Easement Area is more particularly described, according to the Easement Plan, on Exhibit B attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, MEC has agreed to grant the City such easement subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, for consideration paid this day in the amount of Two Thousand Twenty Dollars (\$2,020.00) by the Grantee to Company, and the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties covenant and agree as follows:

A. GRANT OF EASEMENT

1. MEC hereby grants to the City, its successors and assigns, and the City hereby accepts from MEC for itself and its successors and assigns, without covenants, the permanent right and easement (hereinafter the "Easement") to construct, install, operate, repair, use and maintain the following improvements within the Easement Area for the sole purpose of using the same for access between the City Easement Parcels by foot and by vehicle: (i) a paved sidewalk; (ii) a paved roadway for vehicular access between the City Easement Parcels; (iii) limited grading and (iv) gates to restrict access for unauthorized vehicles at each end of the driveway crossing the Property (collectively, the "Improvements"), which Improvements are more particularly shown on that improvements plan (the "Improvements Plan") entitled: "FINAL GRADING AND IMPROVEMENTS PLAN HAVERHILL LANDFILL—NORTHERN MOUND & LOT 26 ASH AREA HAVERHILL, MASSACHUSETTS, C-2A," Scale: 1"=20', Date: Aug. 25, last revised prepared by Langdon Environmental LLC of Portsmouth, NH, a reduced copy of which Improvements Plan is attached hereto as Exhibit C and made a part hereof. Collectively, the Easement Plan and the Improvements Plan ar expersed to in this Agreement as the "Plan."

The Improvements shall be located and constituted in accordance with specifications set forth in the Improvements Plan, and the terms are conditions and agreement. The City covenants and agrees with MEC that the Improvements shall only be constructed or installed by the City in the Easement thea, and that no other improvements shall be installed on the Property or the Easement Area where than the Improvements.

The City covenants and agree of provide MEC with a final "as built" plan prepared by a registered professional engine indicatile the exact location of the Improvements and all final grades with the Property and certifying that the Improvements has been located in strict compliance with a Plan.

- 2. with MEC that the Easement Area is being granted by The City venants and agre "WHERE IS" and "WITH ALL FAULTS," and that MEC has made no warranty of cerning the condition thereof, environmental or otherwise, MEC "AS representation ment Area for the City's use or its Improvements. MEC is or the adequacy store, repair or maintain the Easement Area or the Improvements under no obligation or to render the Easement Area or Improvements serviceable for access or passage or any other purpose in any respect, and specifically, without limitation, MEC will have no obligation to remove accumulated debris, water, ice or snow, which shall the sole responsibility of the City. THE CITY HEREBY WAIVES AND MEC HEREBY DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES OF ANY TYPE OR ANY KIND WHATSOEVER AS TO THE EASEMENT AREA, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THOSE OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND USE.
- 3. MEC, for itself, its successors and assigns, reserves the right to use the land encumbered by the Easement for any and all activities connected with its present or future operations, including, but not limited to, the rights to pass and repass with vehicles and equipment of various loads over the Easement Area and the right to construct, reconstruct, install, maintain, repair, renew, replace, operate and add to any existing or future facilities to meet the needs of MEC's existing or future business; provided, however, that MEC agrees that it will not unreasonably interfere with the Easement. The City covenants and

agrees with MEC that the City, its successors and assigns, will not hinder or interfere with any of said activities or with MEC's access to its existing or future structures or utility facilities or to the Property. The City covenants and agrees with MEC that neither MEC, nor its affiliates, nor any employee or agent of any of them, shall be liable to the City or its successors or assigns with respect to any claims or causes of action or rights to payment of any damages, costs or expenses (including, without limitation, damage to the Improvements) resulting from or in any way connected with the rights herein reserved, including but not limited to damage caused by voltage, fault current or ground current. The City's exercise of its rights in connection with this Agreement and use of the Easement Area and Improvements is at the City's sole risk. The City hereby further releases all of said parties from any and all such claims or demands. This provision shall survive any release or termination of this Agreement.

B. CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE IMPROVEMENTS

The City covenants and agrees with MEC that the City, its agents, employees, licensees, servants, contractors and invitees, shall take all necessary precautions for the safety of the City, its agents, employees, licensees, servants, contractors and invitees on, about or within the Easement Area and shall comply with all Applicable Laws (as hereinafter defined) to prevent accidents or injury to persons or property on, about or adjacent to the Property and the Easement Area, including, without limitation, the National Electric Safety Code, 220 CMR 125.00 ("Installation and Maintenance of Electric Transmission"), MGL Chapter 166 Section 21A ("Coming into Close Proximity to High Voltage Lines" except that the required clearance of six feet is insufficient and the minimum clearance allowed by OSHA as hereinafter described shall be maintained), and all OSHA regulations governing working clearances to electric distribution and transmission lines. Although OSHA Regulations 29 CFR 1926 Subpart CC and 29 CFR

Upon completion a construction or future maintenance, the City will properly restore the Easement Area and property, in MEC's sole discretion, to as good as a condition as existed prior to the commencement of the work, including, without limitation, replacing all earth and soil removed or disturbed by the location, construction, operation, repair, use and maintenance of the Improvements, re-vegetating all areas disturbed, and restoring the Property to its original grade and contour and flush with any manholes or drains.
- 7. The City covenants and agrees that it will not place any below or above-ground structures within the Property, including pull boxes, lights, signs, sheds, septic systems, pools, manholes or other below or above ground structures, except for the Improvements as shown on the Plan.
- 8. The City covenants and agrees with MEC that the City shall not conduct any blasting or use any explosives at or within the Property, including, without limitation, the Easement Area.
- 9. The City covenants and agrees with MEC that, except as shown on the Plan, the City

shall not conduct any work, including, without limitation, any excavation work, or use any vehicles within twenty-five feet (25') plus two and one half (2.5) times the depth of the cut from any of MEC's structures or facilities existing as of the date of execution of this Agreement, including any transmission line poles, towers, guys and anchors, and that the top of any slopes resulting from any such work shall not be within fifty feet (50') of any structure or facility at the Property existing as of the date of execution of this Agreement. Upon completion of the excavation, the slopes of any banks shall be graded on a slope no steeper than one (1) vertical to five (5) horizontal and stabilized with vegetation or rip rap. C. INDEMNITY AND INSURANCE

1. The City agrees, strictly to the extent permitted by law (and/or to the extent of the City's insurance coverage under which MEC is named an additional insured as set forth in Exhibit D) or shall cause any party performing work at the Property on behalf of the City to agree, to defend with counsel reasonably satisfactory to MEC and to pay, protect, indemnify and save harmless MEC, its employees, agents, directors, officers, affiliates, attorneys, consultants, contractors and subcontractors, from and against any and all liabilities, damages, costs, expenses (including any and all attorney's fees and expenses of MEC), causes of action, suits, claims, demands or judgments of any nature whatsoever arising from the condition of the Property, the exercise of this Agreement, and (i) any work, act or omission to act done in, on or in the Property, including the Easement Area, or any part thereof, by or on behalf of the City or any person claiming under the City, or the employees, agents, tenants, contractors, licensees, invitees or visitors (including the general public) of the City or any such person (collectively, the "City Parties"); (ii) injury to, or the death of, persons or damage to property on the Property, including the

Easement Area, or upon adjoining property or in any way growing out of or connected with the installation, construction, use, non-use, condition, possession, operation, maintenance, management, occupation, or repair of the Improvements or the Property, including the Easement Area, by or on behalf of the City or any of the City Parties, or resulting from the condition of the Property, including the Easement Area; or (iii) violation of any agreement or condition of this Agreement or of Applicable Laws or any other requirements affecting the Improvements, the Property or the Easement Area, or the ownership, occupancy or use thereof. The foregoing indemnification shall not include injury or damage directly caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of MEC or its agents or employees. The City shall take prompt action to defend or indemnify MEC against claims, actual or threatened, but in no event later than notice by MEC to the City of the service of a notice, summons, complaint, petition or other service of process against MEC, alleging damage, injury, liability, or expenses attributed in any way to this Agreement or the acts, fault, negligence, equipment, materials, properties, facilities, personnel, or property of the City, its agents, employees, contractors or suppliers. The City shall defend any such claim or threatened claim, including, as applicable, engagement of legal counsel, to respond to, defen settle, or compromise any claim or et for threatened claim. Furthermore and except as ove, the City understands and agrees it is responsible for any and all costs incurred by MEC to enforce ph shall survive any release this indemnification provision. The provision. this para or termination of this Agreement.

- 2. The provisions of this paragraph shall survive any release of this Agreement.
- 3. The City agrees to pay to MEC upon presentation of an invoice, any and all reasonable costs and expenses for environmental assessment, remediation or response activities, including attorney's fees, which MEC may incur as a result of existing conditions on the

- Property that are discovered as a result of the activities of the City or any of the City Parties while performing work on the Property including within the Easement Area. The provisions of this paragraph shall survive any release of this Agreement.
- 4. The City covenants and agrees with MEC that the City shall pay all contractors and/or laborers performing or providing materials for construction, installation, maintenance, and repair of the Improvements so as not to cause or permit any liens, including without limitation mechanics' or materialmens' liens, to be recorded or filed against the Property, and, strictly to the extent permitted by law and/or to the extent of the City's insurance coverage (under which MEC is named an additional insured as set forth in Exhibit D), or shall cause any party performing work at the Property on behalf of the City to, indemnify and hold MEC harmless for, from and against any loss, claim, damage, liability, cost or expense, including attorney's fees and expenses, caused by any such contractor or laborer or occasioned as a result of any such lien being recorded or filed against the Property. It is the intention of the parties hereto that the consideration set forth herein is for access for the non-recreational uses. Accordingly, to the fullest extent permitted by law, for the period of time when the general public may be using the Easement Area, the parties agree and it is the intention that MEC be afforded all of the rights, protections, privileges and benefits of M.G.L. c.21, §17C, or its successor statute or any other state or local law that affords the same or similar protections to landowners when granting access to the general public, and as such, MEC and all those claiming by, through or under MEC, shall not be liable for personal injuries or property damage sustained by members of the public in connection with the rights granted hereunder.

D. PERMITS AND LICENSES; COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

- 1. The City covenants and agrees with MEC that the City shall obtain and be solely responsible for all required permits, licenses, rights or other authorizations, including without limitation all necessary environmental permits, licenses, rights or other authorizations, necessary for the work permitted herein with the Easement Area, including the installation, construction, operation, repair, use, and maintenance of the Improvements, and shall promptly provide all copies thereof to MEC.
- 2. The City covenants and agrees with MEC that the City shall, at its own cost and expense, observe and comply with all applicable present and future laws, ordinances, requirements, orders, directives, rules and regulations of all federal, state and local governments, and all other governmental authorities having jurisdiction over the Improvements or any part thereof, whether the same are in force at the execution of this Agreement or may in the future be passed, enacted or directed including, without limitation, any Environmental Laws (collectively, the "Applicable Laws"), and the City shall pay all costs, expenses, liabilities, losses, damages, fines, penalties, claim, and demands, including counsel fees and expenses, that may in any manner arise and of the city to comply with the covenants of the barr tap.

2. Any party may change the address at which it is to receive notices by giving notice to the other party as hereinabove set forth. Any notice or other communication in connection

with this Agreement shall be deemed duly served when received (or upon attempted delivery if delivery is not accepted).

F. TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS/TERMINATION

- 1. Notwithstanding anything herein contained to the contrary, in the event that MEC determines, in its sole discretion, that the condition of the Easement Area constitutes a safety and/or security risk, MEC may immediately restrict access to the Easement Area so long as such condition exists in MEC's sole discretion and shall provide the City written notice of the condition(s) creating such safety and/or security risk and the steps the City needs to take to resolve the same. In addition, MEC expressly reserves the right to enter upon the Easement Area at any time for any purpose whatsoever in connection with its business operations and to temporarily restrict or prohibit access to and along the Easement Area when required by MEC's operational needs as determined by MEC in its sole reasonable discretion. MEC shall endeavor to give the City at least forty eight hours prior verbal notice of any such restriction or prohibition on access to the Easement Area along with the estimated duration of such restricti or prohibition (provided that MEC) shall not be bound by such estimate), except he event of an emergency, prior at (a notice shall not be required but shall be given s soon as practicable and (b) no notice shall be required for routine maintenan rithout limitation, tree ncludin. prohibite trimming) or in the event that access is restricted less than 48 hours.

upon, within, or about the Easement Area including, without limitation, installing signage to deter and deny entry to MEC's adjacent Property and maintaining any enclosures (such as fences) and providing for gates, watchmen or other security as necessary in order to prevent unauthorized or inappropriate activities, accidents or injury to persons and property on, about the Easement Area or MEC's property including the Property adjacent thereto.

- 4. The City agrees that upon any release or termination of the Easement, the City shall restore the Easement Area to a condition satisfactory to MEC as soon as practicable but in no event later than thirty (30) days following such release. If the City fails to commence such restoration, then MEC may, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the City, perform such restoration at the City's sole cost and expense.
- 5. The rights and easements created hereunder shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of MEC and the City and their respective successors and assigns.

From the commencement of this Agreement, through expiration, termination or longer where specified below, the City shall provide and maintain at its own expense, insurance policies that are meant to be primary and non-contributory (with no right of contribution by any other coverage available to the Company, the Company's affiliates and their respective agents, employees, directors and other parties that the Company may identify) and issued by reputable insurance companies, acceptable to National Grid USA (the "Company") with an A.M. Best rating of A- or better which meet or exceeds the requirements listed herein. Such policies, where required below shall include "Massachusetts Electric Company, National Grid USA, and its direct parent, subsidiaries, affiliates, successors and assigns" (collectively, the "Insured Entities") as Additional Insureds. Waiver of Subrogation, where required below shall be in favor of such Additional Insureds/Insured Entities for any loss or damage covered under those policies referenced in this Insurance Exhibit, or for any required coverage that may be self-insured by the City.

City Council Order Increase the Early Sign-Up Bonus for Snow Plowing Contractors

Attached for your review and approval is an updated City Council Order revising the early sign-up bonus for snow plowing, clearing, and hauling services for the 2025–2026 winter season.

The base hourly rates for snow plowing and hauling services were last updated by City Council Order Document 98, adopted October 22, 2024. Those base rates remain unchanged.

To encourage timely registration and inspection of contractor vehicles and equipment, this proposed order increases the early sign-up bonus by \$2 per hour across the truck and tractor categories. The bonus applies only to vendors who complete all required documentation and inspections by November 14, 2025.

This adjustment reflects higher operating costs for contractors and aims to strengthen participation in the City's snow and ice response program by incentivizing early sign-ups to ensure readiness before winter begins.

If the proposed Order is acceptable, please forward it to the City Clerk to be placed on the agenda for the next City Council meeting.

Attached are the revenue and expense reports through September 30, 2025.

At a high level, the general fund revenue report indicates a year-over-year increase of 6.67%. However, this figure includes earnings from investments, property tax revenue, and Commonwealth funding designated for the School Department under the Student Opportunity Act. When we focus solely on local receipts, which range from motor vehicle excise to miscellaneous revenue, there is a year-over-year decrease of 5.7%. We will continue to monitor this closely to determine whether it is an emerging trend or just an anomaly.

The general fund and enterprise operating budgets are currently meeting expectations.

Over the past month, the finance departments have collaborated with our auditors to conclude the federal audit for fiscal year 2024. We have also made significant progress in finalizing the fiscal year 2025 audit, which I expect to be completed by the end of December. Additionally, we have submitted the free cash for certification to the Department of Revenue (DOR). Finally, I anticipate that we will fill the last two open finance positions—Assistant Treasurer/Collector and Payroll Manager—within the next month.

A review was done of the first several hundred feet of River Street, on the north side of road, as it was brought to our attention that there were discrepancies between City Code and actual signage, and that several buildings that were previously partially commercial are now all residential. The attached Ordinance cleans this up and only has time limited parking in front of businesses.

Also, on 11/9/23 I wrote an Ordinance for handicap parking in front of 151 River Street (HPS-23-18) and the Council passed it on 11/28/23. While Highway Department did install the sign, this is not reflected in City Code, so should be added.

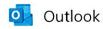
