- 1. Wainwright Investment Counsel (WIC) provided a market update as of June 6, 2023. Wainwright Investment Counsel (WIC) discussed the April 2023 performance.
- 2. Wainwright Investment Counsel (WIC) provided a rebalancing report as of June 6, 2023. Wainwright Investment Counsel (WIC) also updated the year-to-date net distributions from partnerships through the same period.
- 3. Wainwright Investment Counsel (WIC) provided preliminary performance for Putnam Investments and Fisher Investments as of May 31, 2023.
- 4. Wainwright Investment Counsel (WIC) presented a summary of all the partnerships as of December 31, 2022.
