<u>Summary:</u> Marissa Valentino from Nitsch Engineering and Michele Rogers from Dore Whittier Architects outlined the project. TW asked for clarity on the retaining wall. MR explained the design. JR asked if she can vote on this or if she should abstain. RM said she can. HW asked to show where the current outfall is. MV explained the existing swale and outfall setup. HW asked if they would be able to accommodate moving that

outfall to the other corner from west to the south. This has been revised. FC read comments/recommendations from RM.

6. MISCELLANEOUS

6.1. Robert Johnson from Johnson Construction Corp to present redevelopment concept for 880 Boston Rd

<u>Summary</u>: Robert Johnson presented from 14 Lexington Street in Stoneham, MA. HW asked to clarify where the perennial stream is. RJ showed its location and explained that they would be removing the asphalt in the river. AO asked how many trees are going to be removed. RJ said most likely 12-15 and the majority will be on the Boston Road side. They also plan on planting some additional trees. TW asked what a pet wash is. RJ explained. FC asked to clarify if there is a way to extend the 15' buffer off the vegetated wetland. RJ said they cannot move it anymore, if that area became a problem, they would probably look at recreating some wetlands. HW asked about parking and RJ said all parking would be on site. HW asked about snow storage, RJ said they are thinking of the permeable area up top. RJ said there would be a third-party review for stormwater if this goes forward. TW asked if they have conducted a site visit, RM said it is a terrific win for that brook. TW asked about flooding and RJ said if the asphalt is removed in that stream, it would benefit the area.
