### CITY OF HAVERHILL

In Municipal Council

ORDERED:

That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to grant on behalf of the City of Haverhill a certain electric easement for the premises located at 131 Amesbury Road to Massachusetts Electric Company, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

#### GRANT OF EASEMENT

CITY OF HAVERHILL, a municipal corporation having a usual place of business at 4 Summer Street, Haverhill, Massachusetts 01830 (hereinafter referred to as the Grantor), for consideration of One (\$1.00) dollar, grants to MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY, a Massachusetts corporation with its usual place of business at 40 Sylvan Road, Waltham, Massachusetts 02451 (hereinafter referred to as the Grantee) with quitclaim covenants, the perpetual right and easement to install, construct, reconstruct, repair, replace, add to, maintain and operate for the transmission of high and low voltage electric current and for the transmission of intelligence, lines to consist of, but not limited to, five (5) poles, (which may be erected at different times) with wires and cables strung upon and from the same and all necessary anchors, guys, and appurtenances (hereinafter referred to as the "OVERHEAD SYSTEM") and "UNDERGROUND ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM" (hereinafter referred to as the "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM") located in Haverhill, Essex County, Massachusetts, consisting of lines of buried wires and cables and lines of wires and cables installed in underground conduits, together with all equipment and appurtenances thereto for the transmission of intelligence and for the furnishing of electric service to the herein described premises and others, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, but specifically including the following equipment, namely: manholes, manhole openings, bollards, handholes, junction boxes, transformers, transformer vaults, padmounts, padmount transformers and all housings, connectors, switches, conduits, cables and wires all located within the easement area of the hereinafter described property.

Said "OVERHEAD SYSTEM" and "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM" are located in, through, under, over, across and upon a certain parcel of land situated on the southerly side of Amesbury Road and Kenoza Street, being more particularly described in those certain Orders of Taking recorded with the Essex South District Registry of Deeds (the "Registry") in Book 1359, Page 479, in Book 1360, Page 301, and in Book 1400, Page 79.

Said "OVERHEAD SYSTEM" is to originate from Pole P. 14, which is located on the northerly side of Amesbury Road, then proceed in a southeasterly direction from said Pole P.14, crossing Amesbury Road over, upon and across land of the Grantor to Poles P.14-1, P.14-2, P.14-3, P.14-4, and P.14-5.

And further, said "OVERHEAD SYSTEM" and "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM" (locations of the electrical equipment and other facilities on the hereinbefore referred to premises of the Grantor) are approximately shown on a sketch entitled: "ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT; nationalgrid; Owner(s): CITY OF HAVERHILL; Address: 131 AMESBURY RD, HAVERHILL, MA," dated October 20, 2017, a reduced copy of said sketch is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and recorded herewith, copies of which are in the possession of the Grantor and Grantee herein, but the final definitive locations of said "OVERHEAD SYSTEM" and "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM" shall become established by and upon the installation and erection thereof by the Grantee.

Also with the further perpetual right and easement from time to time without further payment therefore to pass and repass over, across and upon said land of the Grantor as is reasonable and necessary in order to renew, replace, repair, remove, add to, maintain, operate, patrol and otherwise change said "OVERHEAD SYSTEM" and "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM" and each and every part thereof and to make such other excavation or excavations as may be reasonably necessary in the opinion and judgment of the Grantee, its successors and assigns, and to clear and keep cleared the portions and areas of the premises wherein the "OVERHEAD SYSTEM" and "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM" are specifically located, as shown on the sketch herein referred to, of such trees, shrubs, bushes, above ground and below ground structures, objects and surfaces, as may, in the opinion and judgment of the Grantee, interfere with the efficient and safe operation and maintenance of the "OVERHEAD SYSTEM" and "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM" and other related electrical equipment. However, said Grantee, its successors and assigns, will properly backfill said excavation or excavations and restore the surface of the land to as reasonably good condition as said surface was in immediately prior to the excavation or excavations thereof.

If said herein referred to locations as approximately shown on the sketch herein also referred to are unsuitable for the purposes of the Grantee, its successors and assigns, then said locations may be changed to areas mutually satisfactory to both the Grantor and the Grantee herein; and further, said newly agreed to locations shall be indicated and shown on the sketch above referred to by proper amendment or amendments thereto. The Grantor, for itself, its successors and assigns, covenant and agrees with the Grantee, for itself, its successors and assigns, that this Grant of Easement and the location of the Overhead System and Underground System may not be changed or modified without the written consent of the Grantee, its successors and assigns, which consent may be withheld by the Grantee in its sole discretion.

It is the intention of the Grantor to grant to the Grantee, its successors and assigns, all the rights and easements aforesaid and any and all additional and/or incidental rights needed to install, erect, maintain and operate within the Grantor's land an "OVERHEAD SYSTEM" and "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM" for the transmission of intelligence and for the purpose of supplying electric service for the building, buildings or proposed buildings shown on the last herein referred to sketch or amended sketch and the right to service others from said "OVERHEAD SYSTEM" and "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM".

It is agreed that the "OVERHEAD SYSTEM and "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM" shall remain the property of the Grantee, its successors and assigns, and that the Grantee, its successors and assigns, shall pay all taxes assessed thereon. Grantor agrees that the rights and easement herein granted are for the purpose of providing service to Grantor's property and the further right to service others from said "OVERHEAD SYSTEM" and "UNDERGROUND SYSTEM".





Petition of Boston Gas Company and Colonial Gas Company, each doing business as National Grid, pursuant to G.L. c. 164, § 94 and 220 CMR 5.00, for Approval of General Increases in Base Distribution Rates for Gas Service.

On November 15, 2017, Boston Gas Company ("Boston Gas") and Colonial Gas Company ("Colonial Gas"), each doing business as National Grid ("National Grid" or "Companies"), filed a petition with the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") for an increase in gas base distribution rates. The Department has docketed this matter as D.P.U. 17-170, and has suspended the effective date of the proposed rate increase until October 1, 2018, to investigate the propriety of the Companies' request. The Companies represent that they will implement any change in rates beginning November 1, 2018.

The Companies seek approval for base distribution revenue increases of \$178,905,053 for Boston Gas and \$32,112,986 for Colonial Gas. The Companies also propose to eliminate the amounts recovered through the targeted infrastructure recovery program and reduce the amounts recovered through the gas system enhancement plan and instead recover them through distribution rates. Based on this proposal, the overall revenue increases sought are \$68,188,370 for Boston Gas, which represents an increase of 13.0 percent on a total bill basis, and \$19,213,443 for Colonial Gas, which represents an increase of 17.0 percent on a total bill basis. National Grid states that if its petition is approved as requested, the proposed revenue increases will have the following effects:

### For Boston Gas Customers:

- a typical residential non-heating customer using 90 therms per year will experience an annual bill increase of \$33.94, or 15 percent;
- a typical residential heating customer using 744 therms per year will experience an annual bill increase of \$80.17, or seven percent; and
- Commercial and industrial ("C&I") customers will experience annual increases in the range of two percent to 23 percent, depending on the amount of their usage.

### For Colonial Gas Customers:

- a typical residential non-heating customer using 78 therms per year will experience an annual bill increase of \$25.75, or 13 percent;
- a typical residential heating customer using 678 therms per year will experience an annual bill increase of \$63.90, or seven percent; and
- C&I customers will experience annual increases in the range of four percent to 17 percent, depending on the amount of their usage.

The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts ("Attorney General") has filed a notice to intervene in this matter pursuant to G.L. c. 12, § 11E. Further, pursuant to G.L. c. 12, § 11E(b), the Attorney General has filed a notice of retention of experts and consultants to assist in her investigation of the Companies' filing, and has requested Department approval to spend up to \$250,000 in this regard. Pursuant to G.L. c. 12, § 11E(b), the costs incurred by the Attorney General relative to her retention of experts and consultants may be recovered in the Companies' rates.

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

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE

CHAPTER 240

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Haverhill that the Code of the City of Haverhill, Chapter 240, ARTICLE XIII. Schedules is hereby amended as follows:

#### WASHINGTON STREET:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of Chapter 240, "ARTICLE XIII. Schedules", parking in the current two - two (2) hour spaces - in front of 170 Washington Street, south side, and nearest to the Comeau Bridge, shall be time limited to fifteen (15) minute spaces solely for the purpose of loading and unloading. These provisions shall be in force until June 19, 2018, at which time the above spaces shall revert to two (2) hour spaces.
