Bassam Geha appeared on this application. Mr. Geha indicated that he will push the tables away from the door area, as there is plenty of room. Commissioner Edwards indicated that Patio 2 was not a real patio, but an entrance to the function hall. Commissioner Edwards inquired about the dates and times Mr. Geha wants to be able to serve on the patio. He requested May 1st to October 15th and was agreeable to limiting service of alcohol to 9:30 on the patio. Commissioner Sewell requested Mr. Geha to sign his plan limiting the tables to seven and also stated he would like to impose a one year restriction on the patio. Mr. Geha has met with the neighbors and they have worked out all the differences. They are now in support of this application, but did not attend the meeting. Chairman Edwards inquired about cameras on the premises. Mr. Geha has cameras on the bars, but only one outside as the parking lot is very large. Captain Doherty of the Haverhill Police Department suggested Mr. Geha may want to look into cameras on the exterior of the building at least as a deterrent and a protection for him and his family. Motion to approve the terrace (Patio 1) on the plan from May 1st to October 15th, excluding the entrance way to the function hall (Patio 2) for one year. If there are no problems with the patio, then the approval will continue automatically. The Patio will be used for alcohol service until 9:30 PM made by Commissioner Sewell, seconded by Commissioner Coco. No public comment on this matter. Vote unanimous, motion passed.
